Requirements

- Registered domain (example.com)

- **Does your Business have an existing website?**


- **Yes** - our business has an existing hosted website

SUB DOMAIN PROPERTY COMPASS CONFIGURATION

- If your business has a website i.e www.example.com then you more then likely have domain hosting and we suggest creating a sub domain to point to your property compass site. For example: <http://investments.example.com> or <http://property.example.com>

This can be done by logging into your hosting providers administration area and editing the DNS settings for your site as per the example below. In the below example a "property" sub domain has been created , but your business may use whatever name they like.

PRIMARY DOMAIN PROPERTY COMPASS CONFIGURATION

- If your business does *not* have a website and you would like to use a registered domain just for your property compass site then a different process is required.
 - ◆ Log into your registry provider
 - ◆ Edit your domain and change your name server settings to point to:
 - ◇ ns1-alpha.aussiehq.net.au
 - ◇ ns2-alpha.aussiehq.net.au
 - ◇ ns3-alpha.aussiehq.net.au

- **No** - but we plan to have a business website in the near future

- It is advisable in this case to secure domain/website hosting and then proceed with a sub domain property compass configuration.
